

Registration Rules for Foreign Players

Japan Hockey Association executes a registration process for foreign players based on the rules as follows.

- 1 . Foreign players mean players who have a nationality except Japanese one.
However, players, who graduated from junior high schools or high schools based on Japanese School Education Act, are not included.
- 2 . In registration, foreign players submit in the next document to Japan Hockey Association through each prefectural hockey association and undergo their examination.
 - (1) A Permission from an association in a home country
 - (2) A Copy for Immigration Checks with a proof of 3 months stay. (Working Visa)
 - (3) A Copy for an Alien Registration Card from a local government office
- 3 . Foreign Players are not permitted to register a team except national teams in a home country.
- 4 . Registrations per year are within 4 players.

Implementation Outline related with a Game Participation of Foreign Players

A Game Participation of foreign players is specified in the implementation outline and executed as follows.

- 1 . One team consists of not more than 4 foreign players.
- 2 . During a game, only 3 foreign players are permitted to play in a field.
